Frequently Asked Questions

1. What does the program cost?

- i. One year tuition for the CCHA is \$6800.00 (taxes included)

2. Am I required to pay the entirety of the program cost upfront?

- i. Programs fees can be payable in four separate installments. An additional 2% financing fee is associated with the payment plan.
 - a) Upon Registration: \$1,836
 - b) Sept 1/17: \$1,700
 - c) Nov. 1/17: \$1,700
 - d) Feb. 1/18: \$1,700

3. Where will the academic education portion take place?

- i. All academic education components will take place at Lester B. Pearson H.S. Participants in the program would have a special timetable to accommodate their on and off ice training.

4. Is transportation included?

- i. Bus transportation between the Richcraft Sensplex and Lester B. Pearson High School during the school day is included in the cost of registration and will be provided for all CCHA participants. Parents or Guardians are responsible for arranging morning drop off at the Richcraft Sensplex and afternoon pick up at Lester B Pearson High School.

All CCHA participants will also be issued an OC Transpo Presto pass to aid with transportation.

5. Where does my son or daughter's equipment go after ice sessions?

- i. Storage space will be provided for participant's equipment at Lester B. Pearson H.S.

6. Is there a dress code? What kind of clothing/ gear is required?

- i. On-ice training – the CCHA requires that all students wear full CSA approved equipment for all ice sessions. Any player missing a piece of equipment will not be permitted on the ice for that session. A mouth guard is optional, though recommended.

Off-ice training - the Titan Performance Centers requires all students wear athletic gear – gym shorts, socks, cross trainers and CCHA provided moisture-wicking shirts.

The CCHA is pleased to provide students with a full apparel package which will include:

- a) A reversible CCHA jersey with matching hockey socks
- b) CCHA tracksuit
- c) CCHA workout gear including shorts and moisture-wicking shirts (2) which are to be worn during all training sessions.
