# **Program Features**

The Ottawa Senators Hockey Programs are proud to offer a NEW spring hockey program like no other featuring a combination of ice times at our Sensplex facilities, tournament entries and BRAND NEW Senators Spring AAA uniforms.

All those associated with Senators Spring AAA Hockey Development Program must at all times adhere to the highest moral and ethical standards, always preaching and practicing sportsmanship, and respect of teammates, coaches, parents, opponents and officials. Failure to comply may result in the cancellation of any or all programs features, including the right to operate under the Senators Spring AAA Hockey Development banner.

#### Each team is provided with the following:

- **Ice time** at the premium Sensplex facilities
  - Option of taking either the gold package (14 hours) or silver package (8 hours) at our premium Sensplex facilities.
    - In order to ensure the best ice allocation, teams will be asked to choose whether they are based in the west end or east end of Ottawa.
- Two (2) complimentary hours at our 20, 000 square foot indoor **filed house** (subject to availability at time of reservation).
- Unlimited use of **Rogers Nielsen Coaches Room** (for player/coach meetings, video sessions, chalk-talk, or parent meetings).
- Entry as host team into the **Senators AAA Spring Cup Tournament** (May 2018) along with discounted entry into all other Sensplex-hosted Spring AAA tournaments (including Capital Spring Roundup Capital Victoria Day Classic).
- One or two **elite level skill development session** designed in consultation with coaching staff and led by Ottawa Senators Hockey Programs Head Instructors.
- Use of two full sets of custom-built home and away jerseys featuring our BRAND NEW design (or available for purchase) unique to the Senators Spring Hockey Development program.
- Home and away socks to keep and the use of matching pant shells.
- Dryland sessions available at a group discounted price which are overseen by Ottawa Senators strength & conditioning coach Chris Schwarz and his FitQuest team.
- Optional add-on for a minimum of 8 players to join the Ottawa Senators Youth Spring 4-on-4/3-on-3 (&/or Youth Summer Leagues after the spring season concludes). The HIGHLY recommended add-on has been chosen by five previous Senators spring hockey teams to rave reviews as the perfect development complement to regular team practices and games.

### **GOLD PACKAGE**

### **SILVER PACKAGE**

**Option A –** Includes all program features listed above as well as eight (8) hours of ice and the rental of jerseys and pant shells.

**Option B –** Includes all program features listed above as well as eight (8) hours of ice and the rental of pant shells (team purchase of Senators Spring AAA Hockey Development jerseys separate).

- \$3,875

Program fee payments will be split into a deposit, and two separate installments, as follows:

- **Payment #1:** \$400 team deposit upon confirmation of team
- Payment #2: Due no later than March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019
- Payment #3: Due no later than February 1st, 2019

### **Team Uniforms**

Each Senators Spring AAA Hockey Development Team will have access to the following:

- Two full sets of custom-built home and away jerseys featuring BRAND NEW design unique to the Senators Spring Hockey Development program. \*These jerseys are rented for the year, and will be returned at the end of the season.
- Matching pant shells to be worn by the full Senators Spring AAA Hockey
  Development team. \*These pant shells are rented for the year, and will be returned at
  the end of the season.
- A pair of home and away socks for each player to be kept at the end of the season.



# Ice Scheduling

In order to ensure the best ice allocation, teams will be asked to choose whether they are based in the west end or east end of Ottawa.

- Blackout dates must be provided by January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019
- Teams will be provided their ice allotment by February 15<sup>th</sup> provided blackout dates have been submitted.

Games Per Team: FOUR (4) GAME MINIMUM (up to 7 possible)

**Format:** 4 round robin games (or 3 round robin followed by guaranteed playoff game) plus playoffs. Novice & Atom 3x12 minute stop time periods, Peewee & Bantam 2x12, 1x15 minute stop time periods. Novice through Minor Peewee will be NON-CONTACT. Minor Bantam division will be BODY CONTACT. Depending on size and makeup, some divisions MAY be split into exclusive groups (tiers or simply groupings), at the sole discretion of the tournament committee. **Format:** 4 round robin games (or 3 round robin followed by guaranteed playoff game) plus playoffs. Pre-Novice (IP): 2x10, 1x12 minute periods, Novice & Atom: 3x12 minute stop time periods. Peewee & Bantam: 2x12, 1x15 minute stop time periods. IP-Atom levels will be NON-CONTACT. Major Peewee & up will be CONTACT. Depending on size and makeup, some divisions MAY be split into exclusive groups (tiers or simply groupings), at the sole discretion of the tournament committee.
