

SENSPLEX (Public Skating) Conditions of Use (COVID-19)

STEP 3

- 1) All users must comply with all current guidelines, regulations and recommendations related to COVID-19 by Ottawa Public Health, the Municipal and Provincial government, the sport governing body, and their Association.
- 2) All individuals must complete an assessment prior to entering the facility. All assessments must be completed the same day clients are attending the public skating.
- 3) All participants must pre-screened themselves and their dependents for COVID-19. Pre-screening must be done the day of the public skating. Below are samples of pre-screening questionnaires for your reference.

- 4) Each group is permitted to use the change rooms; however, they should take into consideration the make-up of their group (e.g. age, gender) before deciding if group wishes to have participants arrive to the facility in full equipment or not.
 - a. With a limited number of people permitted in each dressing room due to physical distancing, some participants will be required to get changed outside the room on chairs. Therefore, plan accordingly to guarantee that participants are **NOT** inappropriately undressed in the hallway.
 - b. Showering is permitted but must remain physically distanced (2 meters).
- 5) Participants must **remain** in their designated spot in the dressing room/chair, until the ice is ready. **Nobody** is to be on the bench during a flood.
- 6) **No admittance** to building until 30min before scheduled ice time.
- 7) Groups **must** vacate the dressing rooms/chairs within 20min of getting off the ice.
- 8) A mask must always be worn by participants & spectators when they are entering/exiting their activity.
 - a. Participants may remove their masks just before the public skating begins.
- 9) **CAPACITY (skating area)** - There are only 40 designated spots for each public skate.
- 10) The Sensplex has a **zero tolerance** Harassment Policy. All individuals must maintain respect for staff and patrons in the facility.
- 11) The Sensplex **Conditions of Use** protocols must always be followed. Failure to comply will result in immediate removal from the facility, non-refundable rental cancellation, and review of future bookings.
- 12) All individuals must comply with all current OPH recommendations and directives related to COVID-19. Please visit www.ottawapublichealth.ca to learn more.
